The CBSE class X & XII results notched another milestone of outstanding success for the school. It was indeed a triumph of hard work and perseverance which finally bore fruit and exploded in a deluge of congratulatory messages pouring in from all quarters.

Result of class X and XII:In class X, 162 students had appeared for the CBSE board exam, out of which, 121 students secured distinction, 22 students secured first class, 12 students secured second class and 7 students secured the pass class. 51 children scored above 90 percent. The class X toppers include Miss Malvika Nalavade (97.8%), Master Ashutosh Porwal (97.4%) and Master Ankush Shetty (96.8%).In class XII, 26 students had appeared for the CBSE class XII board exams. The school achieved a 100% result out of which 13 students secured distinction, 08 students secured first class and 05 students secured the second class. The toppers include Miss Aditi Desai -96.8%, Mission Anisha Jadhav - 93.2%, Master Anshul Dandinawar - 91%
